Voting Tips

- Use only dark blue or black ink.
- Fill in the boxes completely: no check marks, Xs or circling!
- You can vote for all Democratic candidates at once by choosing STRAIGHT PARTY.
- Be sure to vote in ALL non-partisan races and ballot proposals.

Voting by Absentee Ballot

- If you still need an absentee ballot, request one from your city/township clerk.
- Absentee ballots must be received by your local clerk's office no later than 8 p.m. on November 8.
- You can:
 - Deliver it to the dropbox or in person at your clerk's office.
 - Mail (use two first-class stamps) by Friday, October 21.
- Only immediate family members or those who reside with the voter can drop off another person's absentee ballot.
- If you make a mistake, turn in your ballot to your clerk's office and request a new ballot.

Voting in Person on Election Day

- Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on November 8.
- You have the right to vote if you are in line by 8 p.m. Stay in line!
